

7. Synchronise your SDA with myUemis for the first time.
Click “Synchronise” ④. If you have not saved the details in the SDA enter the user name and password of your my-Uemis or DiveWorld account. Note that these are case sensitive, and then click on “Synchronise” ④. This will synchronise your SDA with your private database on myUemis.
Later, log in to <http://www.uemis.com/en/myuemis> and, under “My databases”, select your new SDA. Complete the contact and divespots details. These will be transferred to your SDA upon the next synchronisation.
Close the “SDA” removable media by using the function “Safely Remove Hardware” or “Eject SDA”.
8. Acquaint yourself with the screens, warnings and operation of the SDA during dives (>19, >24).
Nitrox or multigas divers: Acquaint yourself in addition with the nitrox/multigas screens, warnings and operation (>29).
9. Read the complete user manual (www.uemis.com).
10. In the logbook, open the sample dive and “recreate” it in the logbook (see “Logbook” >31, >32).
11. Before each dive carry out the preparations and checks described in the section “Before the Dive” >16 et seq.
12. Acquaint yourself with the use of the wrist strap (see section “Wrist strap” >7).
13. Should you still feel unsure about the use of the SDA, read through the corresponding section once again.

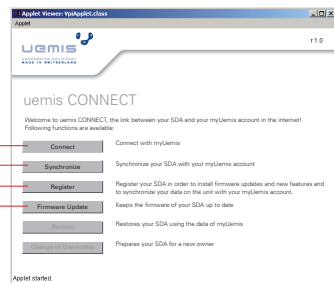
So that you can quickly become acquainted with the SDA we suggest you follow the following procedure:
(The cross references refer to the detailed user manual which you can download from <http://www.uemis.com/en/support/downloads>.)

1. Charge the battery of the SDA (see “Charging the battery” >42).
2. Become acquainted with the operation of the SDA and with the Home screen (see “Display and Operation” >8).
3. Make the SDA your personal dive buddy:
 - Select Setup > User >13 and select your desired language.
 - Enter your nickname >13 so the device can be identified (for further information see “Nickname” >38).
 - **Important!** In the same menu, select the user profile that best describes your level of training (air, nitrox or multigas diver). The subsequent input screens will then be adjusted to match your user profile.
 - Select Setup Units+Formats. Select the desired units >14.
4. **Important!** During synchronisation >37 the UTC time among others, is synchronised. The SDA computes the displayed time from the UTC time and the entered time zone (>14, >41) (time difference). If the wrong time zone is entered the SDA will display the wrong time. You will find a time zone map on page >41. Select Setup > Time+Date >14. Enter the date and time details in the following order: date, time zone, summer time and local time.
5. Register your SDA! (The registration process is described on the following page.)
Once your SDA has been registered the following options and benefits will be available to you:



- You will be notified about updates
- New firmware with security updates can be installed
- New firmware with new features can be installed
- Simple entry of additional information and dive notes using your computer
- Import dive site details from uemis DiveWorld to the dive site database of the SDA
- Import buddies from uemis DiveWorld to the contact database of the SDA
- Use the logbook across the Internet
- Expansion of the dive profile with pictures and text
- Option to share individual dive information with buddies

Procedure: Turn the SDA on. Connect the SDA to a computer with access to the Internet using the USB cable. In the computer (My Computer) window, a removable media icon will appear as “SDA”. Double-click the file ‘SyncSDA.html’ contained inside “SDA”. The browser will open the following window.



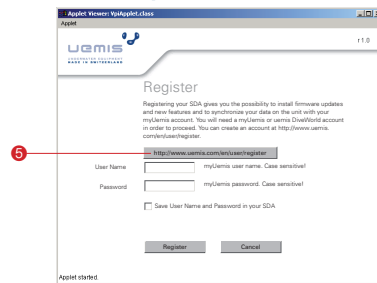
Uemis CONNECT window

Click “Connect” ①.

Click “Register” ②.

Important! If you have created a DiveWorld account you may skip the following section “Create a myUemis account”. Use the uemis DiveWorld account instead of the myUemis account.

Registering the SDA

Enter the user name and password of your myUemis or DiveWorld account. Note that these are case sensitive! If required, check “Save User Name and Password in your SDA” and then click “Register”. This connects your SDA with your user account at myUemis. Log-in to myUemis (<http://www.uemis.com/en/myuemis>) and complete your user profile.

6. Carry out a firmware update:

Caution! During a firmware update the connection between the SDA/computer/Internet must not be interrupted. Your Internet connection must be stable for a firmware update to be carried out.

Click “Firmware Update” ③. Downloading the firmware update can take several minutes, depending upon the speed of your Internet connection.

After finishing the Firmware Update: Disconnect the SDA from the computer. Wait for a few seconds and then reconnect the SDA and the computer. In the Computer (My Computer) window, the “SDA” removable media icon will appear again. Double-click the file ‘SyncSDA.html’ contained inside “SDA”. The browser will open the uemis CONNECT window.

Click this link ⑤ (<http://www.uemis.com/en/user/register>) and create your user account. You will find all further instructions once the log-on window has opened. You will receive an e-mail with a link to click for confirmation. Return to the uemis CONNECT window.
